MAP OF NEST LOCATIONS

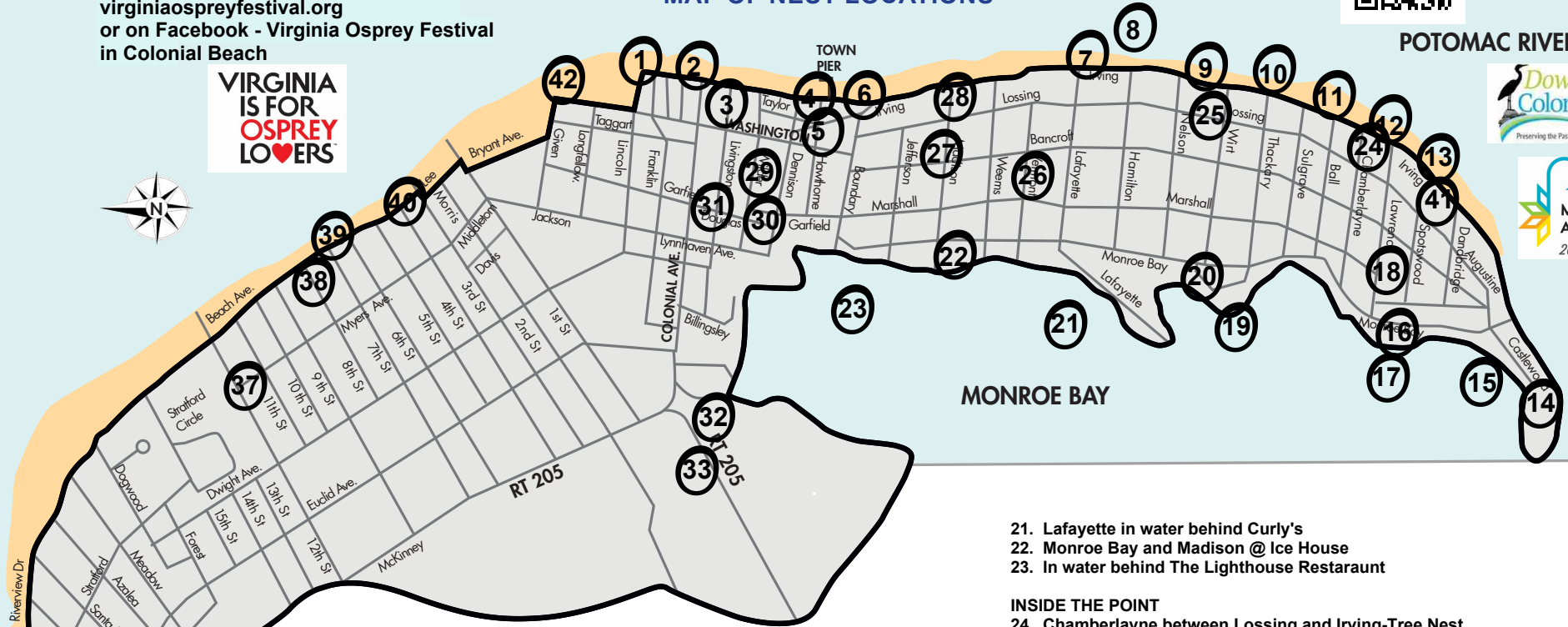
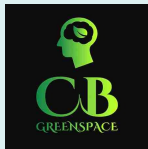
